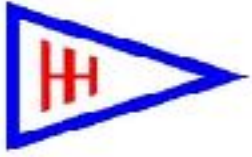

Leveraging our Excellent Financial Status

At our December Board of Stewards meeting we heard from Treasurer, Barry Moore, that the club is in exceptionally good financial shape and that we will end our year with a budget surplus. Of course some of those monies may be used for clubhouse and grounds improvements and/or projects, and some will be required for unexpected equipment repair or replacement. But unless some huge unanticipated expense arises, there will be a surplus at year end.

That being the case, the Yacht Club is presented with a great opportunity to use that surplus to strengthen our club in two ways: 1) begin to accrue

funds for “required and anticipated maintenance and/or capital expenses”; and 2) to pay down the mortgage on our facility.

To initiate the accrual effort, I’ve asked the two most knowledgeable YC members, Sonny Compher and Ernie Ahr, to help us develop a list of 1) anticipated future capital and maintenance matters, 2) when they are anticipated to arise, and 3) what they might cost. Once we get the schedule in place we will decide how to allocate funds between capital needs and loan repayment”.

In yet a third action item, Rear Commodore, Mary Ryan, proposed the formation of a “FUN(d) Committee” to develop additional group activities. You can read more about Mary’s proposal elsewhere in the Main Sheet.

The Yacht Club is “on the move”, and everyone is invited to come along for the ride and even to “drive the bus.”

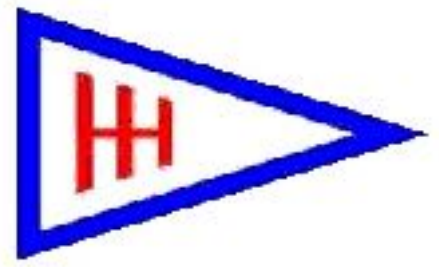
Members Come Together to Cleanup the Grounds
